Ordinance Regulating the Use of Town Road Right-Of-Ways

Ordinance No. 17-004

WHEREAS the Town of Bridge Creek has exclusive use and control of all town road right-of-ways;

WHEREAS, the regulation of activities and use of town right-of-ways are necessary to promote the health, safety and welfare of all those using town roads;

WHEREAS, private use of town right-of ways have caused safety and welfare concerns for motorists and other persons utilizing town roads;

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Town of Bridge Creek to regulate its right-of-ways to promote the health, safety and welfare of all persons utilizing town roads.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Town Board of the Town of Bridge Creek, Eau Claire County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain as follows:

1. Prohibition of the use of Town Right-of-Ways. The Town of Bridge Creek has exclusive use of its right-of-ways and all other use whether for private, commercial, business, industrial or any other purpose is prohibited. Such prohibited use includes, but is not limited to, the parking or storage of equipment, vehicles, machinery, or any other property, pasturing, grazing, fencing of any kind and the placement of signs or other structures in the right-of-way.

2. Penalties. Violation of this section shall result in forfeitures of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$1,000.00 for each day of non-compliance. Each day of non-compliance is considered a separate penalty.

3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective July 2017 upon passage and publication as provided by law.
